

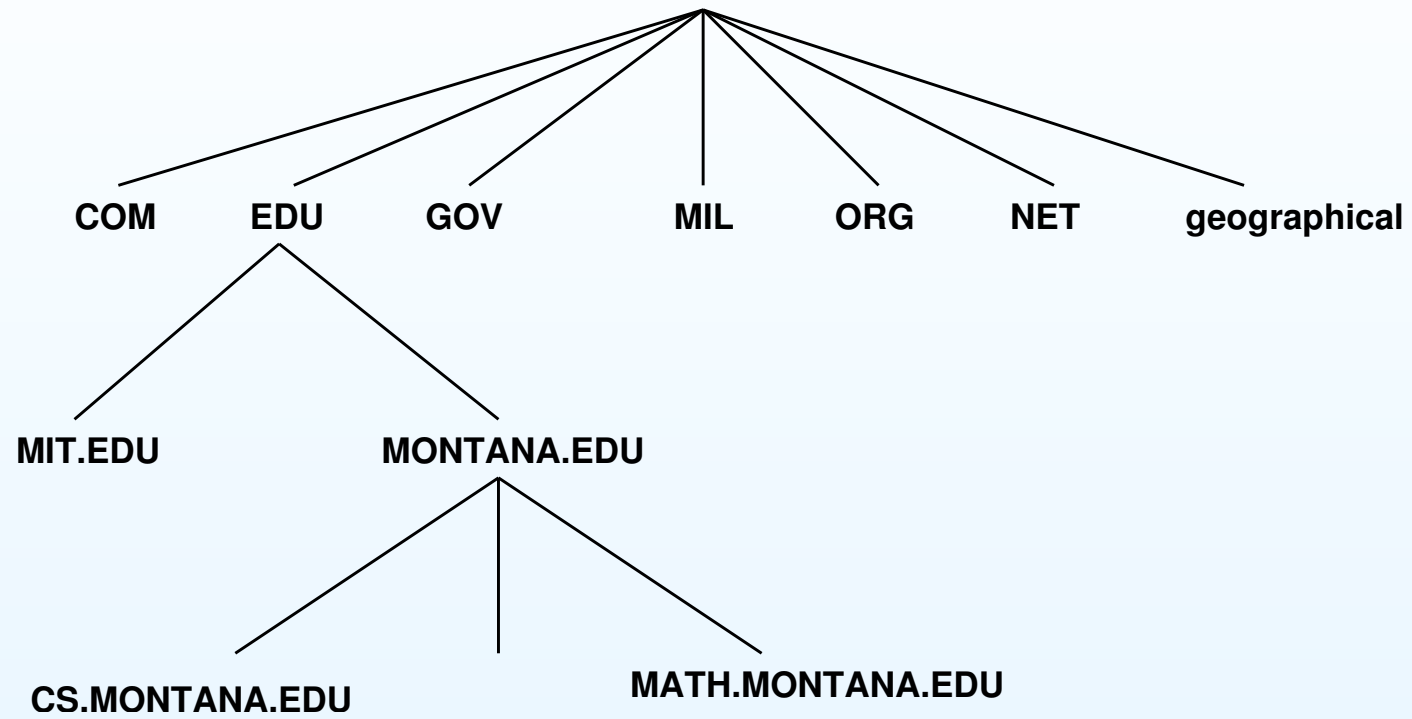
# The Domain Name System

The Domain Name System is system for mapping names to IP addresses.

- Originally designed by Paul Mockapetris at USC and implemented as Jeeves in 1983.
- Bill Joy and others were developing Berkeley Unix and included it as the Berkeley Internet Name Domain system (BIND).
